<p>Analysis of Progress</p> <p>Progress information in Communications is reported using bespoke assessment hierarchies on EARWIG. Pupil engagement progress and focus and listening skills are also captured using a bespoke assessment hierarchy drawing on The Rochford Review and AET information.</p> <p>All Year 7 pupils were assessed as having made progress in communication, listening and engagement.</p>
